

#### **Father Scott's Sharing Spot**

#### A Message from Father Scott VanDerveer, Pastor at St. Mary's Church



Dear Parish Family,

Two weeks ago at all of our Masses, Jason McLaughlin, the Executive Director of the WAIT House educated and impressed our community with the incredible work being done to help homeless and vulnerable teens just a 5-minute walk a few short blocks away from St. Mary's.

This first week of Lent, with the blessing of Parish Finance Council in collaboration with the Parish Social Justice Committee, St. Mary's will begin donating 10% of our weekly collections to the WAIT House.

Each of the five Sundays of Lent we will take the combined revenue the parish has received by envelopes, cash and e-



giving, total it up, and write a check for 10% of that amount to the WAIT House. These five donations representing 10% of our collections on March 8/9, 15/16, 22/23, 29/30, and April 5/6 will make a huge difference in the lives of the youth and young adults (ages 16-24) that the WAIT House serves.

To date, the WAIT House's Emergency Shelter Program has provided shelter and services to over 1,700 local homeless youth and their families. WAIT House's Transitional Living
Program has provided a roof overhead,
support and guidance to nearly 200
local pregnant and parenting youth and
over 120 of their dependents. The
Street Outreach program helps
homeless youth and provides the kind
of support and guidance to protect
those in danger from being
manipulated or trafficked.

Giving 10% of our collection ("tithing") requires courage because it asks us to trust that God will provide. By freely offering a tenth of our blessings, we acknowledge that all we have is ultimately a gift from God. This act of trust is a risky leap of faith, shifting our focus from scarcity to abundance, as we believe in God's promise to care for us. When we give generously, we open our hearts to receiving in unexpected ways—spiritually, relationally, and financially, too. Tithing is not just about finances; it is a spiritual discipline that deepens our relationship with God and strengthens our reliance on divine providence.

Fasting, prayer and almsgiving: what better way to celebrate Lent?


