## **Father Scott's Sharing Spot**

#### A Message from Father Scott VanDerveer, Pastor at St. Mary's Church



Dear Parish Family,

Lent. It begins on Wednesday.

Most of us remember the tradition of giving something up for the 40 days of Lent: chocolate, dessert, maybe alcohol. And that's still a perfectly valid and praiseworthy practice. It disciplines us and helps us pay better attention to our struggles and cravings – and we all need that. Lent is our annual tune-up... and because it only comes once a year, it's worth our effort.

Many people recommend that in place of giving something up, you can instead add some good practice to your life that you wouldn't normally do. Perhaps it means to give \$20 a week away to strangers who need it... or to call a lonely relative once a week. And that has just as much merit as denying yourself something you crave.

So, what are you going to do this year? Have you decided?

During this Jubilee Year of Hope, Pope Francis said, we are called to find ways to become "tangible signs of hope for those of our brothers and sisters who experience hardship." He proposed a number of concrete ways to do this.

He encouraged parishioners to consider joining a jail or prison ministry this year. As he called it, "to open a Holy Door" and walk through it into a prison, just as he will open the Holy Doors in the four major Roman basilicas this year. The Residents Encounter Christ program is looking for volunteers: https://recrcda.org/ Might this be your call?

Pope Francis called on believers to be "signs of hope" to migrants who leave their homelands in search of a better life for themselves and their families.

If you have a neighbor or co-worker who came from another land, learn more about their story and see if you can be part of making their time here easier to bear, especially during days when rhetoric against immigrants is so loud and harsh.

Then in a powerful plea, Pope Francis said, "I ask with all my heart that we grant hope to the billions of the poor, who often lack the essentials of life." Some of the poorest people in our community are the homeless teens and vulnerable youth who are served by the WAIT House. As a sign of our care for them, we are going to donate 10% of our St. Mary's weekly collections during the five weekends of Lent to the WAIT House. Is there another cause close to your heart that you would consider donating sacrificially each week or each month to support?

Pope Francis called on more affluent nations "to forgive the debts of countries that will never be able to repay them." Nothing makes a stronger statement of support than to relent on a debt for someone who is being crushed by the weight of it. Is there someone in your life who owes you who could be set free if you were to forgive part (or all) of their debt?

It's amazing how something the Pope is asking us to think about globally can also be brought right down to our own households and relationships. Whatever you choose to do, may your Lent be infused with hope.
