#### **Father Scott's Sharing Spot**

A Message from Father Scott VanDerveer, Pastor at St. Mary's Church



Dear Parish Family,

The academics at St. Mary's Academy are excellent. The learning going on at SMA each day continues a 142-year tradition of this jewelbox of learning in the center of Glens Falls.

Academics and safety are the top priorities of our principal, and Mrs. Hauser devotes significant time and attention each day to monitoring student outcomes and measuring academic success.

But, in my opinion, in a community like ours, with excellent public schools in every direction, academics, as good as they are at SMA, would not necessarily be my greatest motivation as a parent in sending my child to Catholic school.

In 2017, Harvard School of Education asked 10,000 middle school students whether their parents cared more about them getting good grades or being kind. 80 percent said their parents' emphasis was on grades. Research and surveys are showing that American parents have an increasing focus on grades and sports. Grades and sports are important, but ignoring other aspects of what kids need to learn is resulting in school days of metal detectors, emergency lockdowns, and a growing discomfort with the kind of things our kids are picking up "by osmosis."

Parents around here know that a solid education is being provided in our local public schools. But we have to acknowledge that the values we want our kids to have will not be picked up by osmosis in an environment where God is not acknowledged.

At SMA, kids hold doors, respectfully greet adults, power down their devices, close their eyes and bow their heads when they pray.

The low student/teacher ratio means that every child is watched throughout the day with care and attention. Bad days are noticed, melancholy is met with comfort, concerns are addressed right away, there are no drugs in our bathrooms.

The columnist David Brooks notes in his book The Road To Character that today, our honor societies are filled with students that have achieved the highest grades. By many, honor is defined only as achievement. At SMA, we see honor through a bigger lens.

Our graduates regularly wind up in the top 10 of their senior class, but they are not just achievers. They are kind, compassionate humanitarians who have been exposed to big ideas and a transcendent understanding of life in this amazing divinely-created universe. In our unique environment, faith and knowledge intertwine. Our kids learn to pray for people experiencing illness, carry boxes of donations to our food pantry, and speak up when they see something wrong.

On Sunday, February 2 at 12:30 (directly following the 11:15 Mass), we will welcome one and all to come through the beautiful Gothic doors of SMA to experience what makes this form of education different at our Open House. Whether you have school-age children or not, we encourage you to come and feel the pride of knowing what our Catholic community is providing for this generation of parents and kids. Enjoy some refreshments and see for yourself what a positive impact this holistic educational approach has and will continue to have on Glens Falls and on our world.
