

Father Scott's Sharing Spot

A Message from Father Scott VanDerveer, Pastor at St. Mary's Church



Dear Parish Family,

The WAIT House has learned a lot about how to help homeless and vulnerable youth and young adults in the almost 30 years since being founded in 1998. Jason McLaughlin, the executive director, was telling me recently about the ways boundaries and expectations are managed in working with people in the midst of surviving so many kinds of crisis and chaos.

He told me that after lots of trial and error over the years, the WAIT House staff finally asked the young people: "What kind of home do YOU want to live in? How do we create that kind of home here?" Through lots of dialogue, they established that everyone wanted a home that was safe, where the others living there could be expected to act responsibility and show respect for others in the house. That led to reflecting on what behaviors and traits demonstrate integrity, responsibility and respect in people.

It was the residents of the WAIT House who created an agreement, which they call their "Core Values and Way of Being." Everyone who moves in must agree to these and sign the covenant. They are...

INTEGRITY

Be committed: set high behavior standards and stick to them even in difficult situations.

Be courageous: stand up for what you believe is just and good.

Be honest: choose words and actions that are sincere, not misleading.

Be disciplined: remain dedicated and self-controlled, even when challenged.

Be resilient: learn from mistakes and losses; seize the opportunity to improve.

RESPONSIBILITY

Be helpful: understand and advance the house's positive goals.

Be conscientious: be aware and careful of the choices you make.

Be accountable: accept that your actions impact everyone around you.

Be persevering: work through difficulty and discouragement.

Be reliable: prove that others can depend on you.

RESPECT

Be accepting: support everyone's worth and dignity, regardless of background, abilities, or beliefs.

Be considerate: always be aware of and honor others rights and feelings.

Be attentive: be ready to learn from others.

Be encouraging: demonstrate concern for the growth and development of all others.

Be appreciative: value the guidance of supportive adults and peers.

What a list! I ask you: how many members of Congress live up to the qualities listed here on a consistent basis? Isn't it amazing how little we expect from many powerful adults and yet how much we expect from young people? If a homeless youth acts up, we want to throw the book at them, yet we accept so much from people who hold positions of responsibility and honor. I think that gives us a lot to think about.

May God bless our Lenten efforts to uplift our vulnerable youth and support the holy work of the WAIT House.


