Father Scott's Sharing Spot

A Message from Father Scott VanDerveer, Pastor at St. Mary's Church



Dear Parish Family,

Advent is the perfect time for a fresh start. Research show that it can take as little as 21 days to form a habit, so the four weeks of Advent provide the perfect amount of time for us to undertake some spiritual habit formation. Four weeks is not an overwhelming amount of time to give something a try. Anyone could take a month to experiment with incorporating some new practices.

These days of preparation for Christmas are meant to be marked with hope, peace, joy and love. For many of us, the best way to make room for those new energies is to sweep out the clutter of cynicism, conflict, gloom and division.

Going to Confession is a great a perfect preparation for the preparatory work of Advent. Back by popular demand, we will offer an **Advent Day of Reconciliation**, with multiple priests on duty to hear your confession this **Tuesday 2-6 PM**.

Each time we offer this opportunity, more than 100 people flock to St. Mary's to take advantage of the cathartic power of the Sacrament of Reconciliation. It takes some courage to say out loud the things that have been taking you off the path you wish to travel, but everyone who comes feels like they got an incredible gift in exchange for their vulnerability.

If December 3, doesn't work for you, **St. Michael's** in South Glens Falls will offer a Communal Reconciliation Service on **Tuesday, December 10 at 1:00**. We'll also continue to offer our weekly confessions in the church on **Wednesdays after the 12:10 Mass** during Eucharistic Adoration.

One of my favorite Advent songs, People Look East, describes these days leading up to Christmas as preparation for the arrival of a long-awaited guest. The song says,

"Make your house fair as you are able; Trim your hearth and set the table... Love – the guest – is on the way."

There are few better ways to sweep out our inner house and prepare ourselves for the arrival of Love Incarnate than to account for what in our lives has not expressed our best selves or our highest aspirations. Give yourself the gift of freedom that comes with absolution from the past and a fresh start for the road ahead.


