A Message from Father Scott VanDerveer, Pastor at St. Mary's Church



Dear Parish Family,

Sometimes you don't know how much you need something until you experience it. Our Small Group series on the book Beautiful Hope has been incredibly fruitful for the people who've been participating. Pope Francis knew what he was doing when he declared 2025 Jubilee Year of Hope. We've been living in intense times (quite an understatement!), and there is no way for us to see a future of peace and unity without hope.

Each person is invited to embrace this Jubilee Year as a time of spiritual renewal and concrete action. The Jubilee is marked by four major pillars: **pilgrimage**, reconciliation, charity, and celebration. Throughout the year, we will have opportunities to participate in pilgrimages, engage in acts of mercy, and reflect on the Sacrament of Reconciliation as a means of encountering God's boundless love. A group of us will have the amazing gift of international pilgrimage this week as more than 40 St. Mary's parishioners make a journey to Rome where we will get to see the Holy Door at St. Peter's (an ancient tradition for years of Jubilee) and experience Pope Francis' vision for this year's celebration first-hand.

Now, classically, pilgrimage involves physical travel to a holy place to have an uncommon experience of God. But whether or not you're traveling to Rome, God is fully present to us in each present moment, so we can make a pilgrimage without packing a bag. To begin incorporating this Jubilee into your own experience of 2025, consider... 1. **Beginning each day with a prayer for hope:** Offer your day to God, asking for the grace to trust in God's plan and to see challenges as doorways for growth. We all recognize how this works in retrospect, but hope allows us to know it in real time.

2. Performing small acts of kindness:

Holding a door for someone behind you is not nothing; it may be the first tenderness they have experienced a while. Brighten someone's day with a kind word, a smile, or a helping hand. These small gestures can inspire hope in others.

3. **Reflecting on scripture and inspirational writings:** Spend time with

passages that speak of God's promises,

such as Psalm 27:14 ("Wait for the Lord; be strong, and let your heart take courage; wait for the Lord.").



4. **Reaching out to someone in need:** Whether it's a friend going through a tough time or a stranger facing hardship, your support can be a tangible sign of God's love. People in struggle do not need "answers," just to know they are not alone.

5. Focusing on gratitude: At the end of each day, take a moment to thank God for the blessings you received, no matter how small. Gratitude nurtures a hopeful heart.

Together, let us make 2025 a year of grace and renewal for our parish and our world. With hope and gratitude,
